- v.20-21 When the Greeks said to Philip "we want to see Jesus", they were looking to interview or ask Jesus guestions. Often the guestions we ask are revealing of where we are at – so what questions are you asking of Jesus right now?
- v. 23 Jesus responded to Philip and Andrew by saying 'the hour has come for the son of man to be glorified.' Why now? Meaning, what impact did the Greeks request have on the 'hour?'
- v.24-25 Often in the gospels Jesus tells us to "lose" our life for him (see Mark 8:34-38), and normally this means leaving the idols of our heart. What are some things (idols) that keep us from losing ourselves for Jesus?
- v.25 Looking at the way we spend our time and energy, what is the priority of our lives, the Kingdom of God or our own life? What would it look like in your family, job, and friendships if the Kingdom of God was the top priority?
- v.26 Jesus says "Whoever serves me must follow me; and where I am, my servant also will be." Where do you see God's presence in your life? If it's hard to see him, might it be that we're not following close to him or going to where he is?
- v.26 Is God honoring the life you're living right now? If no, why not? If yes, why? What are practical ways in which God might honor us?
