Growing in Discipleship

DISCIPLESHIP & LEADERSHIP PIPELINE:

All followers of Jesus are called to grow in understanding of Him.

"You must grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ." 2 Peter 3:18

As we grow in our understanding of what Jesus has done for us (salvation), He works in us through the Holy Spirit to mold us to become more like Him (sanctification). We launched the Discipleship & Leadership Pipeline this year to provide a roadmap for growth that focuses on growing in our knowledge of God through study of theology and a pattern for living it out in the context of the church that focuses on how to lead others.

This Pipeline is broken into four chapters:



CHAPTER ONE

Learn the Story: Learn about GENESIS and our mission

CHAPTER FOUR

Continuing the Story: Apprentic elder, church planter or pastor

The GENESIS Network will be made up of one church with multiple congregations in multiple locations. Each church will share the name, DNA, mission, vision, and values of GENESIS in addition to financial and strategic resources such as our discipleship and leadership pipelines. The Network will provide opportunities for future church planters to be raised up, equipped, and empowered to plant healthy gospel-centered churches that help ALL people walk with God.

In September 2021, GENESIS will launch its first network church! GENESIS North Shore will be sent out and planted with Kyle Asmus serving as the local lead pastor. God has already raised up a core community of 40 men and women to come alongside Kyle and his wife Lindsay to establish a new congregation that will focus on reaching the 18 towns in and around the North Shore.

Influencing this region with the gospel message is certainly more than one person can do alone, but it's not more than all of us can do together. Lord willing, through the GENESIS Network, we will see dozens of church planters raised up and sent out so that we can help ALL people walk with God throughout New England.

We're Planting a Church!

We first felt called to church planting as college sophomores. When we moved from Minneapolis to the North Shore of Boston in the fall of 2016 to attend Gordon Conwell Theological Seminary, we became broken over the lack of churches in and around the surrounding cities.

After graduating from seminary, Kyle joined the staff at GENESIS as an associate pastor. In the fall of 2019, with the affirmation and support of the GENESIS elders, we completed and were affirmed for church planting through the SEND Network assessment process.

We immediately entered a season of prayer with one overarching question for God - "Lord, where do you want us to plant a church?" After months of prayerful deliberation, we discerned that God wanted us to plant a church on the North Shore! We are excited to see God multiply all that He has done in and through GENSIS to see Jesus's name made famous. -KYLE AND LINDSAY ASMUS

In October, a group of 40 community members began gathering to pray, plan, and prepare as the Core Team for GENESIS North Shore. They spent time on intentional training, development, and discernment with the goal of discovering the 'why, where, and how' to plant the first GENESIS Network church. God was faithful to answer their prayers! He granted clarity, grew their relationships with Him and each other, and inspired incredible momentum among them.

God-willing, GENESIS North Shore will open in September 2021. Pray that God continues to develop and multiply a community that is passionate about helping all people walk with God, and see individuals and communities restored by the power of the gospel!

Above the Hills Church

In November of 2010, when my beautiful wife, Popia, and I were married, I was already 6 years into pastoring a healthy Cambodian church in Bridgeport, Connecticut. Things were going well, we were stable and comfortable, but we felt a growing restlessness within us. After several conversations with Popia, and praying the dangerous prayer of "Send us," it became clear that the Lord was calling us to the new ministry opportunity of church planting in Popia's hometown of Lynn, MA.

When we relocated, our family hopped from one church to another looking for a place to call home while we developed our plant. We learned about GENESIS through an invite from the SEND Network. I remember walking into GENESIS for the first time. Immediately, Popia and I agreed that it was different, special. We found home!

After passing the planters assessment through North American Missions Board, we were granted the option to do a residency with GENESIS in 2019. During that time, I was invited onto the staff team and my core leadership team committed to serving faithfully. Serving as a church planting resident and staff member at GENESIS gave me opportunities to grow and learn about church planting and church organization while our leadership team continued to seek the Lord on His plans for us with our plant, Above the Hills Church.

The greatest thing we received from our time at GENESIS is the reinforcement of holding both the old and new together in harmony. We learned to absorb everything we could while simultaneously valuing what we've experienced through years of ministry in different locations and contexts. It was an indescribably refining process! We will forever be grateful to have been a part of the GENESIS community.

Now here we are! We are almost ready to plant Above the Hills Church this coming Easter, and we are excited to have GENESIS send us out. The ATHC team has invested a lot of time in building networks and relationships within Lynn in order for us to better understand, love, and serve our community. Though our core community is small in number, we are big in heart. We are a "feet on the ground" and "Bible in hand" church that believes in the reconciliation and transformation of every heart. Please pray for our community, for our leaders, for Above the Hills, and for GENESIS. We are excited for what the Lord is doing!
