Exodus 19: 1-6

## SERMON SUMMARY

Many of struggle to know who we are. That's because we've all become something far less than who God created us to be. The reason why we forget who we are is because we struggle to grasp who God is. Exodus 19: 1-6 is about reclaiming our right identities, and the prescription God's Word give us is this: if you want to know who you are, know who God is. When we start with God's character and attributes, we can then begin to fully understand ourselves. And, our identities are fully reclaimed when we realize we are not what we do, we are what Christ did.

# **BIBLICAL TEXT CITED**

On the third new moon after the people of Israel had gone out of the land of Egypt, on that day they came into the wilderness of Sinai. 2 They set out from Rephidim and came into the wilderness of Sinai, and they encamped in the wilderness. There Israel encamped before the mountain, 3 while Moses went up to God. The Lord



called to him out of the mountain, saying, "Thus you shall say to the house of Jacob, and tell the people of Israel: 4 'You yourselves have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself. 5 Now therefore, if you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession among all peoples, for all the earth is mine; 6 and you shall be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.'
