

## REVEAL

*Psalm 139*

### SUMMARY...

In the **5R** sermon series, we will explore 5 keywords that God uses to help us close the gap between what we believe and how that belief shapes the way we live. In week one, we learned that God **REMINDS** us that He knows where we are and wants us to see Him. This week, we examine what God wants to **REVEAL** to us.

**KEY POINT:** God doesn't reveal out of anger or disappointment. He reveals because He wants to lead us to life! His revelation should lead to confession, repentance, and life in Jesus Christ.

### A FEW QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER...

1. Set the stage: name one person who knows you better than anyone else. What is it about this person that makes it easy for you to be completely honest with them?
2. Read **Psalm 139: 1-4**. What comfort is there in knowing that God knows us better than we know ourselves? Does this bring relief, or do you ever feel condemned or like you're disappointing God? Does that keep you from enjoying Him?
3. Why are honest moments painful moments? Read **Psalm 139: 7-10**. How does God's presence help you in these painfully honest moments? Do you feel comforted or fearful of God being with you at all times?
4. Read **John 10:10**. What type of thieves have crept into your life, especially during this pandemic? In what ways have you found security in Jesus?
5. Read **Psalm 139: 17; 23-24**. What has God been revealing about you to you in this pandemic?
